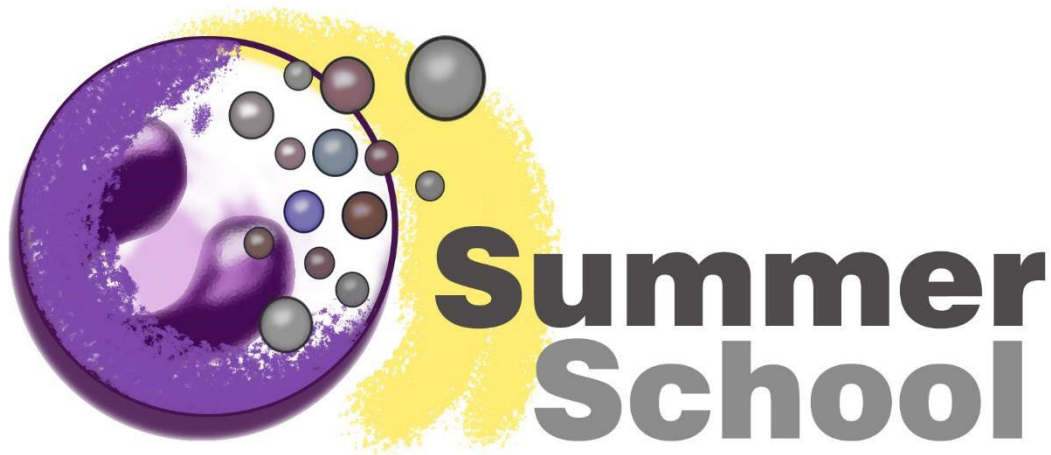

Description: The International Summer School offers the unique possibility of meeting internationally recognized researchers during three days without interruption. Students and faculty members will present their research projects in an informal atmosphere, which include oral presentations, poster sessions and scientific discussions. Students will receive input on their own work and learn how projects are designed by principal investigators. One other important goal is the promotion of future scientific collaborations among the participating groups. The school is open for PhD and MD students and post-docs. The number of participants is limited due to space problems.

The summer school is an accredited course of the Graduate School for Cellular and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Bern (1.0 ECTS). ECTS are only awarded for courses or events, which include some kind of performance assessment (in this case an oral presentation or poster).

Objectives:

Students, post-docs and all participants will:

- Practice the presentation of own scientific data (oral or poster presentation)
- Engage and defend their work during scientific discussions with peers and experts
- Gain insights into on-going research projects in drug discovery and translational medicine
- Receive individual project-related feedback by peers and experts
- Gain innovative ideas (projects, study design, methodology)
- Initiate collaborations with other research groups
- Develop networking skills
