

Students will receive input for their own work and learn how projects are created by principal investigators. One other important goal is the promotion of future scientific collaborations among the participating groups. The school is open for PhD and MD students. The number of students is limited to 30 due to space problems. The summer school is an accredited course of the Graduate School for Cellular and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Bern (8 GCB credits). Furthermore, the meeting is recognized for the continuous medical education and participants receive 16 credits in Allergology and Clinical Immunology FMH as well as 16 credits in Pharmacology SSEP.
